Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorporates by reference herein as though fully set forth the findings made by the Planning Commission in its Resolution No. 14559 adopted March 12, 1998, which stated that the actions contemplated herein are consistent with the General Plan and Eight Priority Policies of Planning Code Section 101.1. A copy of such Resolution is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 012029.

Section 2. In accordance with the Department of Public Works' Order No. 173,197, a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 012029 , Board of Supervisors Ordinance No. 1061, entitled "Regulating the Width of Sidewalks," a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors Book of General Ordinances, in effect May 11, 1910, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

Section 1553. The width of sidewalks on portions of Howard and Minna Streets between 4th and 5th Streets shall be modified as shown on Department of Public Works drawings Q-20-542 and Q-20-543, a copy of each of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 012029.

Section 3. The Department of Public Works, as is necessary as a result of this Ordinance, shall makes arrangements with public utility companies and City departments for the relocation and/or adjustment of such existing utility facilities in the affected sidewalk and street areas.
