WHEREAS, A public hearing on adoption of an amendment to the Redevelopment
Plan for the Yerba Buena Center Project Area (Ordinance No. 98-66, amended by Ordinance
Nos. 202-71, 393-73, 386-76, 376-77, 420-97, 538-81, 477-86, 404-94, and 33-97) to expand
the project area by adding land consisting of a portion of the block bounded by Market,
Fourth, Mission and Fifth Streets and a portion of Mission Street between Fourth and Fifth
Streets, specifically including Assessor's Block 3705, Lots 9, 10, 12, 13, 14, 15, 17, 18, 33, 38
and 43 and known as the "Emporium Site Area" (the "Plan Amendment") was duly noticed and
held by the Board of Supervisors on September 25, 2000, which hearing was continued from
August 28, 2000 and September 18, 2000; and,

WHEREAS, Various objections in writing to adoption of the Plan Amendment were delivered to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors before the hour set for the hearing on the Plan Amendment or at the hearing (collectively, the "Objections"); and,

WHEREAS, No objections in writing were delivered or presented to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors by any affected property owner or taxing entity; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors deferred adoption of the Plan Amendment for one week to provide for consideration of the Objections and adoption of written findings in response thereto, as required by the California Community Redevelopment Law; and,

SUPERVISOR YAKI, BIERMAN BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

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WHEREAS, The Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco has prepared a written response to all of the Objections, describing the disposition of the issues raised and addressing the Objections in detail, including reasons for not accepting the specified objections and suggestions contained therein, and containing a good faith, reasoned analysis of such issues, supported by evidence in the record, a copy of which response is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 001257 (the "Response");

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED, That pursuant to the requirements of the California Community Redevelopment Law (Sections 33363 and 33364 of the Health and Safety Code) the Board of Supervisors has considered the Objections and hereby adopts the Response as its written findings in response to the Objections to the adoption of the Plan Amendment, for the same reasons as set forth in the Response, and hereby incorporates the Response, including the findings contained therein, by reference as though fully set forth in this Motion.
