

1 [Expend DOC Beverage Container Recycling Payment]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the City Administrator to expend retroactively a \$230,484**  
4 **payment from the Department of Conservation (DOC) for Fiscal Year 2000/2001.**

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6 WHEREAS, Recycling conserves resources and is necessary to achieve the state  
7 mandated goal of 50% waste diversion; and,

8 WHEREAS, The City Department of the Environment established the Solid Waste  
9 Management Program, which manages the Curbside Program and other beverage container  
10 recycling programs; and,

11 WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 14581 (a) (4) (A) of the California Public Resources  
12 Code, the DOC is required to make annual payments to eligible cities and counties that  
13 submit the necessary forms; now, therefore, be it

14 RESOLVED, That the ~~City Administrator~~ Department of the Environment is authorized  
15 to expend retroactively a \$230,484 beverage container recycling payment; and be it

16 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the ~~Solid Waste Management Program~~ Department of  
17 the Environment Director is hereby authorized and empowered to execute all necessary forms  
18 for purposes of securing payments and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in  
19 Section 14581 (a) (4) (A) of the California Public Resources Code; and be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives indirect costs as  
21 they are not allowed.
