for the period of July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2010, waiving indirect costs.

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WHEREAS, Department of Public Health, Community Behavioral Health Services (DPH-CBHS) was awarded a grant from the California Department of Rehabilitation (DOR) in the amount of \$3,310,497 (annual amount of \$1,103,499), with a required match provided by DPH-CBHS of \$895,980 (\$298,660 annually), for a budget total of \$4,206,477 (\$1,402,159) annually), for the period of July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, The DOR is establishing a cooperative contract agreement with two DPH-CBHS providers, including Richmond Area Multi-Services (RAMS) Hire Ability Program and Community Vocational Enterprises (CVE) to provide vocational assessment, situational assessment, work adjustment and employment services-employment preparation, job development and placement services to mentally-ill psychiatric patients; and,

WHEREAS, This is the eleventh year that DPH has received grant funds from the DOR for the provision of these services; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the DOR requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 080037; which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

1	WHEREAS, DPH requests retroactive approval to the start of the date on the	
2	agreement, July 1, 2007, due to delays processing the agreement, and because the DOR	
3	requires an approved resolution before the matching funds can be paid; and,	
4	WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment as the agreement funds	
5	no positions through DPH, with positions only through sub-contractors RAMS and CVE; and,	
6	WHEREAS, The DOR does not allow for indirect costs in order to maximize the use of	
7	grant funds on direct services; now, therefore, be it	
8	RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a gran	
9	in the amount of \$3,310,497 from the California Department of Rehabilitation; and, be it	
10	FURTHER RESOLVED, DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend	
11	grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it	
12	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of	
13	indirect costs; and, be it	
14	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the	
15	agreement on behalf of the City.
