

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - San Francisco Public Health Foundation - California  
2 Community Reinvestment Grants Program - \$350,000]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and**  
4 **expend a grant in the amount of \$350,000 from the San Francisco Public Health**  
5 **Foundation to participate in a program, entitled “California Community Reinvestment**  
6 **Grants Program,” for the period of October 1, 2019, through September 30, 2021.**

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8 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Public Health Foundation is the recipient of a grant  
9 award from the California Community Reinvestment Grants Program; and

10 WHEREAS, With a portion of these funds, the San Francisco Public Health Foundation  
11 has subcontracted with the Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of \$350,000 for  
12 the period of October 1, 2019, through September 30, 2021; and

13 WHEREAS, The purpose of this project is to provide mental health treatment,  
14 substance use disorder treatment, system navigation services, and linkages to medical care  
15 for clients returning to the community from prison and community members with a history of  
16 incarceration experience; and

17 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance amendment; and

18 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received  
19 the letter of funding allocation on September 9, 2019, for a project start date of October 1,  
20 2019; and

21 WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of  
22 \$59,400; now, therefore, be it

23 **RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant**  
24 **in the amount of \$350,000 from the San Francisco Public Health Foundation; and, be it**

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1           FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and  
2           expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1;  
3           and, be it

4           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
5           Agreement on behalf of the City.
