13 the Castro District's integral elements, such as Harvey Milk's Camera Shop, the Twin Peaks  
14 Bar, the AIDS Memorial Quilt, the Rainbow flag, the Castro Theatre, the Pink Triangle

16 WHEREAS, Trevor's tour interweaves the human behavior, historical events, and  
17 cultural emotions that have shaped the Castro as far back as the 1850s into a distinctive,  
18 hopeful, view of future possibilities; and,

19 WHEREAS, Trevor has become a Castro District icon, using her eloquence, extensive  
20 knowledge, energy, and kind heart to open the eyes of Castro visitors ranging from tourists to  
21 residents, from straights to gays, from liberals to conservatives, from Catholic priests and
