[Police Code - Access to Reproductive Health Care Facilities]

Ordinance amending the Police Code, Article 43, Sections 4301, 4302, 4303, and 4304, to replace the existing eight-foot bubble zone around individuals entering, exiting, and seeking services at health care facilities with a fixed buffer zone around the entrances, exits, and driveways of reproductive health care facilities; and to prohibit any person from entering or remaining in that buffer zone, with certain exceptions; and making environmental findings.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 130262 and is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The Police Code is hereby amended by amending the title of Article 43 and Sections 4301, 4302, 4303, and 4304, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 43: ACCESS TO REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH CARE FACILITIES

SEC. 4301. FINDINGS

Every person in the City and County of San Francisco ("City") has a fundamental right to privacy protected not only by the United States Constitution, but also explicitly guaranteed in Article I,

1 Section 1 of the California Constitution. This right to privacy includes the right to access all legal
2 health care services, including reproductive health care services.

3 Maintaining access to reproductive health care services is a matter of critical importance not
4 only to individuals, but also to the health, safety, and welfare of all residents of the City. Efforts to
5 harass, obstruct, or otherwise interfere with individuals seeking reproductive health care services may
6 deter, delay, and even prevent individuals from obtaining necessary reproductive health care services.
7 These efforts, which often include forcing patients to run a gauntlet of demonstrators near the
8 entrances, exits, and driveways of reproductive health care facilities, or to confront intimidating
9 demonstrators stationed at or near those entrances, exits, and driveways, also disrupt the ability of staff
10 at reproductive health care facilities to devote their full efforts to providing health care services and
11 divert valuable facility resources away from patients. Actions that result in such obstruction, delay,
12 and deterrence of patients, and diversion of reproductive health care facilities' staff and resources,
13 undermine the City's interest in maintaining the public health, safety, and welfare, and in preserving its
14 residents' constitutional right to privacy.

15 Standing on equal footing with the right to access health care services, including reproductive
16 health care services, are the free speech and assembly rights of those who would gather and raise their
17 voices on matters of public concern. Under this Article, the Board of Supervisors previously attempted
18 to balance these rights by prohibiting harassment, within 100 feet of an exterior wall of a health care
19 facility, of individuals entering, exiting, or seeking services at a health care facility, with harassment
20 defined as "knowingly approach[ing] another person within eight feet of such person, unless such
21 other person consents, for the purpose of passing a leaflet or handbill to, displaying a sign to, or
22 engaging in oral protest, education, or counseling with such other person." That prohibition has
23 proven ineffective. Due to the density and space constraints of the City's urban landscape, that
24 prohibition has not adequately prevented harassment, delay, and deterrence of patients seeking vital
25 health care services, and in particular reproductive health care services, nor adequately prevented

1 distraction and diversion of health care providers from their core mission of providing services in a
2 safe and supportive environment.

3 The Board of Supervisors hereby finds that the creation of a buffer zone, as defined in Police
4 Code Section 4302 as amended by Ordinance No. _____, and a prohibition on entering or
5 remaining in that buffer zone as specified in Police Code Section 4303 as amended by Ordinance
6 No. _____, with certain exceptions, is necessary to promote the full exercise of the right to privacy
7 by patients seeking vital reproductive health care services and is also necessary to maintain public
8 health, safety, and welfare within the City. The Board of Supervisors further finds that this Article
9 strikes a lawful and appropriate accommodation between the right to privacy and to access
10 reproductive health care services and the needs of public health, safety, and welfare, on the one hand,
11 and the rights of free speech and association, on the other.

12 Article 43, as amended by Ordinance No. _____, applies only to reproductive health care
13 facilities, no health care facilities generally. In addition, Article 43, as amended by Ordinance
14 No. _____, does not apply to licensed hospitals or to reproductive health care facilities owned or
15 operated by licensed hospitals. This scope ensures the Article is narrowly tailored to address the
16 significant governmental interests it serves, and leaves other health care facilities and locations
17 available for speech. Individuals attempting to access reproductive health care facilities to obtain
18 reproductive health care services have been subjected to harassing or intimidating activity from
19 extremely close proximity, tending to hamper, delay or deter their access to those facilities and services
20 and thus subverting their legal rights to seek and obtain legal health care services. The Board finds
21 that reproductive health care facilities that are not part of a licensed hospital, and not owned or
22 operated by a licensed hospital, are more vulnerable to such subversion of their patients' rights on
23 account of the layout and design of their facilities and parking areas as well as their staff resources
24 and deployment. Further, reproductive health care facilities not affiliated with hospitals commonly
25 possess fewer resources for providing adequate security and safety to individuals seeking access to

1 reproductive health care services. Thus, Article 43, as amended by Ordinance No.
2 imposes narrowly tailored, content-neutral restrictions where they are most necessary to further the
3 significant government interests the Article serves.

4 The Board finds that the modest scope of the buffer zone is sufficient to ensure that patients may
5 gain safe and unimpeded access to reproductive health care services, while allowing speakers to
6 effectively communicate their messages to their intended audience.

7 The Board further finds that obstructions and demonstrations around the entrances, exits and
8 driveways of reproductive health care facilities can impede pedestrian and vehicle traffic and create
9 safety hazards on the sidewalks and roadways, and that this buffer zone will help promote safe and
10 effective pedestrian and vehicle traffic flow around reproductive health care facilities. In addition, the
11 buffer zone will reduce disputes and confrontations requiring law enforcement services, and will
12 protect property rights.

13 The Board further finds that harassing and intimidating activities conducted around the
14 entrances, exits and driveways of reproductive health care facilities can adversely affect the physical
15 and emotional health and well-being of patients seeking services at a reproductive health care facility.
16 The Board finds that this buffer zone will provide a protective space for patients and thereby help avoid
17 those adverse health consequences.

18 The Board finds that this Article imposes content-neutral time, place, and manner restrictions
19 on speech and association, which are narrowly tailored to serve significant government interests and
20 leave ample alternative channels of communication.

21 This Article is not intended to create any limited, designated or general public fora. Rather it is
22 intended to protect those who seek access to reproductive health care from conduct that violates their
23 rights.

24 The Board of Supervisors finds that every person in the City and County of San Francisco has a
25 basic and fundamental right to privacy protected by the United States Constitution and explicitly

1 guaranteed in California's Constitution, Article I, Section 1, including the right to seek and obtain all
2 health care services permitted under the laws of this State. Central to this right is the need to secure
3 access to all reproductive health care services. Access to these services is a matter of critical
4 importance not only to the individual, but also to the health and welfare of all citizens of the City and
5 County. Intentional efforts to harass an individual in order to deter or prevent the individual from
6 exercising his or her right to seek and obtain health care services are therefore contrary to the interests
7 of the people of San Francisco.

8 The Board of Supervisors finds that for many people seeking access to medical treatment, being
9 forced to run a gauntlet of protestors who intend to deter or impede access to the health care facility
10 can be directly injurious to the patient's health, even if the patient is not physically barred from entry.
11 Other persons may be sufficiently intimidated to put off necessary or timely medical treatment entirely.
12 The Board of Supervisors further finds that protests at the entrance to health care facilities in the City
13 and County of San Francisco have often disrupted the operation of the facilities, as well as the ability
14 of individuals to seek and obtain services within the facilities.

15 In adopting this legislation, the Board of Supervisors recognizes both the fundamental
16 constitutional right to assemble peaceably and to demonstrate on matters of public concern, as well as
17 the right to seek and obtain health care. The Board of Supervisors finds that law enforcement officers
18 often have difficulty determining when the exercise of the right to protest violates the competing right
19 of those seeking access to health care facilities. The Board of Supervisors further finds that the
20 provisions of this ordinance promote the full exercise of these rights and strike an appropriate
21 accommodation between them. The failure of the Board of Supervisors to take steps to accommodate
22 these competing interests may jeopardize the exercise of both privacy and the First Amendment rights.

23 The Board of Supervisors finds that the buffer zone outside of health care facilities established
24 by this legislation ensures that patients have unimpeded access to medical services without unduly
25 impairing the ability of demonstrators to communicate their message to their intended audience. The

1 buffer zone imposes content neutral time, place and manner restrictions, which are tailored to serve a
2 significant government interest, and which leave ample alternative channels of communication.

3 This ordinance is not intended to create any limited, designated or general public fora. Rather it
4 is intended to protect those who seek access to health care from conduct which violates their rights.

5

6 SEC. 4302. DEFINITIONS.

7 (a) For purposes of this Article, the term "buffer zone" refers to a sphere of protection
8 surrounding an individual seeking access to, passage from, or services within a health care facility,
9 when that individual is within 100 feet of an exterior wall of a health care facility. The sphere is
10 delineated by an eight foot radius extending in all directions from the individual seeking access to,
11 passage from, or services within the health care facility. For purposes of this Section, distance shall be
12 measured from any extension of the body of the individual seeking access to, passage from, or services
13 within the facility to any extension of the body of, or any sign or object held by another person.

14 For purposes of this Article:

15 "Buffer zone" refers to the area encompassed by both of the following:

16 (1) the area on a public way or sidewalk encompassed by a radius of 25 feet from any
17 portion of an entrance, exit, or driveway of a reproductive health care facility; and

18 (2) the area encompassed by extending the outside boundaries of any entrance, exit, or
19 driveway of a health care facility in straight lines to the point where those lines intersect the sideline of
20 the street or the property line of the reproductive health care facility.

21 "Demonstration activity" refers to any activity involving expressive or symbolic content,
22 including but not limited to the following: protesting; demonstrating; picketing; displaying or
23 distributing pictures, literature, or other materials; and engaging in education or counseling activities.

24 (b) For purposes of this Article, the term "health care facility" means a facility licensed
25 pursuant to Chapter 1 (commencing with Section 1200) of Division 2 of the Health and Safety Code; a

1 ~~health facility licensed pursuant to Chapter 2 (commencing with Section 1250) of Division 2 of the~~
2 ~~Health and Safety Code; or any facility where medical care is regularly provided to individuals by~~
3 ~~persons licensed under Division 2 (commencing with Section 500) of the Business and Professions~~
4 ~~Code, the Osteopathic Initiative Act, or the Chiropractic Initiative Act, provided that said facility~~
5 ~~provides reproductive health care services.~~

6 "Person" refers to any individual, firm, partnership, joint venture, company, corporation,
7 association, social club, fraternal organization, estate, trust, business trust, receiver, trustee, syndicate,
8 or any other group or combination acting as a unit except the United States of America, the State of
9 California, and any political subdivision of either.

10 "Reproductive health care facility" refers to a clinic licensed under Chapter 1 (commencing
11 with Section 1200) of Division 2 of the Health and Safety Code, or any other facility or business that
12 provides reproductive health care services, exclusively or in addition to other health care services.
13 Reproductive health care facility does not include a licensed hospital or a clinic or other facility owned
14 or operated by a licensed hospital.

15 (c) For purposes of this Article, the term "Reproductive health care services" refers to
16 all medical, surgical, counseling, referral, and informational services related to the human
17 reproductive system.

18 (d) For purposes of this Article, the term "person" shall include, but is not limited to: 1)
19 Individuals; 2) corporations; 3) not for profit organizations; 4) partnerships; 5) associations; and 6)
20 groups or other entities. The term "person" shall not include an individual seeking access to, passage
21 from, or services within a health care facility and his or her escorts.

1 SEC. 4303. HARASSMENT OF INDIVIDUALS SEEKING ACCESS TO ENTERING OR
2 REMAINING IN BUFFER ZONE AT REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH CARE FACILITIES

3 PROHIBITED; EXEMPTIONS.

4 (a) Prohibition. Except as specified in Section 4303(b), it shall be unlawful for any person
5 to enter or remain within a buffer zone harass, as defined in this Article, or attempt to harass an
6 individual entering, exiting, or seeking care inside a health care facility.

7 (b) Exemptions. For purposes of this Article, the term "harassment" refers to situations where,
8 within 100 feet of an exterior wall of a health care facility, a person knowingly approaches another
9 person within eight feet of such person, unless such other person consents, for the purpose of passing a
10 leaflet or handbill to, displaying a sign to, or engaging in oral protest, education, or counseling with
11 such other person. Section 4303(a) shall not apply to the following:

12 (1) Individuals entering or exiting the reproductive health care facility. This exemption
13 allows individuals to enter and pass through the buffer zone only while entering or exiting the
14 reproductive health care facility, and does not permit those individuals to stop or remain in the buffer
15 zone for any purpose, including but not limited to demonstration activity, or to engage in demonstration
16 activity while entering or exiting the reproductive health care facility.

17 (2) Employees, agents, or volunteers of the reproductive health care facility, acting
18 within the scope of their employment, agency, or volunteer service. This exemption does not allow
19 these employees, agents or volunteers to engage in demonstration activity within the buffer zone, even if
20 that demonstration activity is within the scope of their employment, agency, or volunteer service.

21 (3) Law enforcement, emergency medical, firefighting, construction, and utilities
22 personnel and federal, state, and municipal employees, acting within the scope of their employment.
23 This exemption does not allow these individuals to engage in demonstration activity within the buffer
24 zone.

1 (4) Individuals passing temporarily through the buffer zone to reach a destination
2 within or on the other side of the buffer zone. This exemption applies to individuals who enter or pass
3 through the buffer zone, without stopping, either to enter a residence or a business within the buffer
4 zone other than the reproductive health care facility or to reach a destination on the other side of the
5 buffer zone. This exemption does not allow these individuals to engage in demonstration activity while
6 within or passing through the buffer zone. If an individual not subject to the exemptions in subsection
7 (b)(1), (2), or (3) passes through the buffer zone five or more times in an hour, such activity will
8 constitute *prima facie* evidence that the individual has violated Section 4303(a). The individual may
9 rebut that presumption by presenting evidence that he or she has a legitimate personal or business, non
10 demonstration activity purpose for passing through the buffer zone.

11 (c) Business Hours. Section 4303(a) applies only during a reproductive health care facility's
12 posted business hours.

13 (d) Marking and Written Notice. Section 4303(a) applies only if the buffer zone is marked by
14 the Department of Public Works ("DPW") and a notice prepared by DPW is posted conspicuously near
15 the buffer zone. A reproductive health care facility that wants its buffer zone marked and a notice
16 posted shall submit a written request to the Department of Public Works ("DPW"). DPW shall
17 measure and mark the buffer zone within 14 calendar days of the request. The DPW Director or
18 designee shall prepare signs to provide to reproductive health care facilities, upon request, for posting.
19 The signs shall provide notice regarding the prohibitions under this Article. The DPW Director or
20 designee may adopt rules and regulations after a public hearing to set standards for marking and
21 posting a notice at a buffer zone.

22 (e) Other Laws. Nothing in this Article shall preclude the enforcement of other state, federal,
23 or municipal laws inside or outside of the buffer zone, including but not limited to those related to
24 sidewalk obstruction.

1

SEC. 4304. ENFORCEMENT.

2 (a) Criminal Enforcement. Any person who violates Section 4303 of this Article shall be
3 guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by imprisonment
4 incarceration in the County Jail, fine, or both. Upon a first conviction for violation of Section
5 4303, the person shall be imprisoned incarcerated in the County Jail for up to three months, or
6 fined up to \$500, or both. Upon a subsequent conviction for violation of Section 4303, the
7 person shall be imprisoned incarcerated in the County Jail for up to six months, or fined up to
8 \$1000, or both.

9 (b) Civil Enforcement. An aggrieved individual person may enforce the provisions of this
10 Article by means of a civil action. An aggrieved person includes any reproductive health care facility
11 whose buffer zone is the site of a violation of this Article. Any person who violates any of the
12 provisions of this Article or who aids in the violation of this Article shall be liable to the
13 individual aggrieved person for special and general damages, but in no case less than \$1,000
14 plus attorneys' fees and the costs of the action. In addition, punitive damages may be
15 awarded in a proper case.

16 (c) Other Enforcement. Nothing in this Article shall preclude any person from seeking
17 any other remedies, penalties or procedures provided by law.

18


19 Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days from the
20 date of passage.

21

22 Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this Ordinance, the Board intends to
23 amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers,
24 punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Police Code that
25 are explicitly shown in this Ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment additions,

1 and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under the official
2 title of the Ordinance.

LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Police Code - Access to Reproductive Health Care Facilities]

Ordinance amending the Police Code, Article 43, Sections 4301, 4302, 4303, and 4304, to replace the existing eight-foot bubble zone around individuals entering, exiting, and seeking services at health care facilities with a fixed buffer zone around the entrances, exits, and driveways of reproductive health care facilities; and to prohibit any person from entering or remaining in that buffer zone, with certain exceptions; and making environmental findings.

Existing Law

Police Code Article 43 prohibits a person, within 100 feet of an exterior wall of a health care facility, from harassing or attempting to harass an individual entering, exiting, or seeking services at a health care facility. Harassment is defined as "knowingly approach[ing] another person within eight feet of such person, unless such other person consents, for the purpose of passing a leaflet or handbill to, displaying a sign to, or engaging in oral protest, education, or counseling with such other person." Section 4303(b). This type of law, which creates a protective zone around an individual that moves with that individual, is often known as a "bubble zone" law.

Amendments to Current Law

The proposed ordinance would replace the existing bubble zone ordinance and instead set a fixed protective zone around a reproductive health care facility. This type of law is often known as a "buffer zone" law. The proposed ordinance would establish a buffer zone around reproductive health care facilities within the City and County of San Francisco, encompassed by both of the following: (1) the area on a public way or sidewalk encompassed by a radius of 25 feet from any portion of an entrance, exit, or driveway of a reproductive health care facility; and (2) the area encompassed by extending the outside boundaries of any entrance, exit, or driveway of a reproductive health care facility in straight lines to the point where those lines intersect the sideline of the street or the property line of the health care facility. The proposed ordinance would narrow the application of Article 43, which currently applies at health care facilities, so it applies only at reproductive health care facilities. In addition, the proposed ordinance would exclude licensed hospitals and facilities owned or operated by licensed hospitals from the definition of a reproductive health care facility.


The proposed ordinance would prohibit anyone from entering or remaining in the buffer zone during the posted business hours of the reproductive health care facility, with four exceptions: (1) Individuals entering or exiting the reproductive health care facility; (2) Employees, agents, or volunteers of the reproductive health care facility, acting within the scope of their

employment, agency or volunteer service; (3) Law enforcement, emergency medical, firefighting, construction, and utilities personnel and federal, state, and municipal employees, when acting within the scope of their employment; and (4) Individuals passing temporarily through the buffer zone to reach a destination within or on the other side of the buffer zone. The prohibition would apply only if the buffer zone was marked and a notice posted. Under the proposed ordinance, the Department of Public Works would mark the zone and prepare the sign used to provide notice.

Background Information

Several cities and states have adopted buffer zone laws. The City of Santa Barbara has a buffer zone preventing demonstrative activities within eight feet of health care facilities and places of worship. The State of Massachusetts has a buffer zone preventing demonstrative activities within thirty-five feet of reproductive health care facilities, and the City of Pittsburgh has a buffer zone barring people from congregating, patrolling, picketing or demonstrating within fifteen feet of the entrance of a health care facility. The proposed ordinance is modeled on those laws, which have been upheld by the courts.

RE: BUFFER ZONE LEGISLATION

Dear Supervisors Campos, Mar, and Yee:

The San Francisco Women's Political Committee (SFWPC) would like to formally pledge our support for the proposed "Buffer Zone" ordinance, which will enact a fixed 25-foot perimeter around access points to reproductive healthcare facilities.

SFWPC is the largest and most active women's political organization in San Francisco and is committed to educating our members about issues facing women and families, engaging them in the political and legislative processes, and giving them a voice to influence policy. As a stalwart pro-choice organization, we hold reproductive freedom to be one of our most fundamental core issues, and we believe that harassment-free access to reproductive healthcare is an essential aspect of a fair, respectful, and progressive society.

Planned Parenthood Shasta Pacific has persisted in providing quality services to their patients despite aggressive and belligerent protestors who seek to bully them and distribute medically inaccurate reproductive information, and they deserve strong allies from the Board of Supervisors and the San Francisco Police Department in protecting the rights of their patients.

SFWPC recognizes that the "Buffer Zone" ordinance is essential to protecting the rights of patients seeking reproductive care in San Francisco and we urge you to vote to support it.



SITE PLAN



The Department on the Status of Women (DOSW) fully supports the Access to Reproductive Health Care Facilities bill sponsored by Supervisors Campos, Cohen, Kim, Avalos, Wiener, Mar, Breed, and Chiu. The Department on the Status of Women is deeply committed to the safety of women, particularly those who have made the decision to have an abortion, from those who would want to intimidate or physically threaten them.


For support on this issue, we look to the recent decision of the First Circuit Court of Appeals in Eleanor McCullen et al v. Martha Coakley et al that upheld a 35-foot buffer zone around the driveways and entrance clinics in Massachusetts. The decision stated:

...[The buffer zone] represents a permissible response by the Massachusetts legislature to what it reasonably perceived as a significant threat to public safety. It is content- neutral, narrowly tailored, and leaves open ample alternative channels of communication. It is, therefore, a valid time-place- manner regulation, and constitutional on its face.

San Francisco has a long history of supporting reproductive choice, including a 2005 resolution adopted unanimously by the San Francisco Board of Supervisors (file no. 050019), urging all legal authorities to fully facilitate the protection of the right of women to control their reproductive health. This was reiterated in a 2010 Board of Supervisors resolution supporting healthcare reform (file no. 091463).

We applaud the authors and supporters of this important legislation to enhance the safety of the women of San Francisco.

She's Pregnant, and I'm a Father. Where do I go from Here?

That's a good question. And just by asking it, you're on the right track. Standing beside this woman and her child is where you belong. After all, you're the father of the child.

You helped bring the mother and baby to this moment. So it's only right that you should ask questions and help make decisions.

Don't suspect for a moment that this will all go away and be forgotten. It can never be that way. You know that from this day forward, you have created life. Now this life is in your hands.

You need not be powerless or confused. If the people at the abortion clinic or the health department make you feel that way, walk out.

Don't let any one call you a "potential father" with a "potential child." You are a **father** with a **child**, period. The possibilities are unlimited.

According to a national poll, more than half of all fathers—including married men—are not even told that their child has been aborted.²²

Some Important Facts:

Professor Arthur Shostak of Drexel University surveyed 1,000 men working in abortion clinics while their girlfriends and wives were having abortions. He concluded the following:

- 42% of the boyfriends had offered to marry the woman offered child support.
- 25% of the men, regardless of their feelings toward abortion, offered to pay the costs of the abortion procedure.
- 39% of the men believed that life began at conception or when the nervous system began to function.

• 26% believed that the abortion was the "killing of a child."

Shostak's study found a vast range of emotions among the men. They feared for the woman's health, felt guilty about the abortion or the pregnancy, felt self-doubt and also anguish and pain over the loss of their children and over the entire abortion "experience."²³

Some relationships are changed. One man wrote: "It was the end of something between us—on her side, it had killed off trust and a lot of hope, and on my side, all I felt was her resentment and bitterness..."²⁴

Abortion is Not the Only Choice

You need not face this problem alone. There are people who care about you and your baby—people who will help you in this time of desperate need. Abortion is FATAL. Please examine the alternatives!

The Development of Your Unborn Child

On the basis of a menstrual period every 4 weeks:

1. One week after mom misses her first period, your baby's developing heart starts to beat!
2. Two weeks after this missed period, your baby's body systems are present and developing, including its blood circulatory system, the digestive track, nervous system, reproductive and urinary tracts and kidneys.²
3. Four weeks after mom misses her first period, a microscope would reveal that your "little baby" has the characteristic 46 human chromosomes in every cell, demonstrating clearly that this is a human being.³
4. By the time mom misses her second period, your baby's brain is divided into 3 parts – one to experience emotion and understand language, one for hearing and one for seeing.⁴
5. Before mom misses her third period, your baby is well-proportioned, and about the size of a thumb. Every organ is present. The liver is making blood, the kidneys function and the heart beats steadily. Of the 4500 structures in the adult body, 4000 are already present.⁵

Possible Long-term Complications

Guilt and personality disturbances (Post Abortion Syndrome).

In future desired pregnancies:

- Miscarriages⁶
- Premature delivery because of damage to the cervix¹⁶
- Tubal pregnancies (increased from 8 to 20-fold by abortion)¹⁷
- Breast cancer¹⁸

Breast Cancer

An abortion in the early months of pregnancy when estrogen levels are high predisposes a woman to getting breast cancer. In contrast, a full-term pregnancy early in a woman's reproductive life is protective against breast cancer.¹⁹

A 1995 Harvard University study on over 2,000 women in Greece found a significant 51 percent increased breast cancer risk among women who had an abortion.²⁰

A 1994 National Cancer Institute study of over 1,800 women in Washington State found a significant 50 percent increased risk among women who had any abortions. The risk was more than double for women whose abortion (or first abortion) took place before age 18 or over age 30.¹⁸

Abortion Methods

During the First Three Months of Pregnancy:

Suction Aspiration

Also called "vacuum curettage." The mouth (cervix) of the womb is stretched. Sometimes it is damaged because during pregnancy the cervix is closed tightly to protect the baby. A suction curette (hollow tube with a knife-like edged tip) is inserted into the womb. A strong suction tears the baby into pieces, drawing them into a container. Great care must be used to prevent the womb from being torn and in checking body parts to ensure a complete abortion.

Dilation and Curettage (D & C)

Similar to the suction method except for insertion of a loop shaped knife (curette) which cuts the baby apart and scrapes the pieces out through the cervix. Used at up to 14 weeks after the last period.

RU - 486

First, a steroid drug is taken orally which either destroys the baby's placenta or prevents it from being formed. Then, another oral drug, called a prostaglandin, is taken to induce the uterus to contract and push the baby's body out through the vagina. This occurs over a period of days (average is 9-4 days)⁸ and is accompanied by cramping and bleeding like that of a heavy period. In a small percentage of women, some fetal tissue remains and a surgical abortion is required.²¹ Used at 5-9 weeks.

Methotrexate

Similar to RU-486, methotrexate is administered by an intramuscular injection instead of a pill. Then, a suppository of misoprostol is inserted in the vagina to trigger expulsion of the baby from the uterus.

During the Later Stages of Pregnancy:

Dilation and Evacuation (D & E)

The mouth (cervix) of the womb is dilated. A curette is then used to dismember the child, and the parts of the baby's body and its crushed head are removed by ring forceps. This method is used primarily at 13 to 20 weeks gestation.

Prostaglandin Abortion

Prostaglandins are hormones that induce labor. They are injected into the sac surrounding the baby. The mother then goes into labor, giving birth to a child too young to survive. This method is falling out of favor because it is not uncommon for babies to be born alive. Performed in the late second and third trimester.

Hysterotomy

As in a cesarean section, the abdomen and the womb are opened surgically. The baby is then lifted out and the cord clamped. In a hysterotomy, however, the child, usually too young to survive without immediate medical treatment, is put aside to die.

Partial Birth Abortion or Dilation and Extraction (D & X)

While only the baby's head is in the uterus, the abortionist lifts the cervix and applies pressure to the baby's shoulders with the fingers of the left hand. Then a blunt, curved Metzenbaum scissor is forced into the base of the skull. The scissors are spread to enlarge the opening. A suction catheter evacuates the skull contents. The baby is then removed. Performed up to 32 weeks or beyond. This procedure was finally outlawed in 2003 after more than a decade of use. The ban was challenged in the courts by abortion supporters but was finally upheld by the Supreme Court in 2007.

In medical practice, there are few surgical procedures given so little attention and so underrated in its potential hazards as abortion. It is a commonly held view that complications are inevitable.



Complications of Abortion

Possible Immediate Complications

- Excessive bleeding, possibly causing removal of the uterus and a resulting inability to have children⁷
- Bleeding, possibly going on for more than a month after using RU-486⁸
- Puncture and tearing of the womb (uterus)⁸
- Infection (mild to fatal - sometimes parts of the baby are left inside the womb)¹⁰
- Cervical laceration in 5% of women¹¹
- Hepatitis from blood transfusions, blood clots and embolisms¹²
- Sterility, ranging from 2% to 5% of abortions¹³
- Infertility, caused by scraping that damages the lining of the uterus¹⁴



The Role of the Church

The church community announces that they see in the creation of each child a fresh expression of God's unfailing love and their commitment to offer assistance to pregnant mothers in need. They make their message known on a "Sign of Hope" placed in front of their church which also displays the icon depicted on the cover of this brochure along with an expression of outreach - **PREGNANT? NEED HELP?** - and a toll-free phone number (Helpline).




Emotional Toll




Many abortion clinics operate without any staff properly trained in CPR, and even without a trained anesthesiologist.

Clinics that cater to the poor are particularly prone to bad conditions, because the poor and minorities are least likely to report problems.

Regulations on abortion clinics vary from state to state. And, although most states have regulations, they usually are not enforced consistently.

Ordinance amending the Police Code, Article 43, Sections 4301, 4302, 4303, and 4304, to replace the existing eight-foot bubble zone around individuals entering, exiting, and seeking services at health care facilities with a fixed buffer zone around the entrances, exits, and driveways of reproductive health care facilities; and to prohibit any person from entering or remaining in that buffer zone, with certain exceptions; and making environmental findings.
