8	adopted Resolution No. 167-00-PTC authorizing the Director of Property to re-advertise and
9	solicit proposals for the management of the Golden Gateway Garage; and,
10	WHEREAS, On January 16, 2001, ten (10) parking firms obtained bid packages that
11	were made available on December 5, 2000 and eight (8) parking firms submitted proposals
12	by the deadline; and,
13	WHEREAS, A review and analysis of the proposals determined that none of the
14	proposals submitted were in the best interest of the City because none of them provided
15	sufficient assurance that will improve the quality of life of San Francisco residents, merchants,
16	and visitors; and,
17	WHEREAS, On June 19, 2001 the Parking and Traffic Commission adopted
18	Resolution No. 153-01-PTC rejecting all Bid proposals received for the Golden Gateway
	Garage and authorizing the Director of Property to re-advertise the invitation for bids for the
19	management of the Golden Gateway Garage; and,
20	WHEREAS, Twelve (12) parking firms picked up packages, nine (9) firms submitted
21	pre-qualification questionnaires and eight (8) firms were qualified to submit proposals; and,
22	WHEREAS, On September 29, 2001, the Parking Authority and the Real Estate
23	Division received proposals from seven firms and rejected two of the seven firms because of
24	late submittal and lack of required bid security; and,

1	WHEREAS, The four-member panel and the Human Rights Commission evaluated
2	each proposal and ranked the firms; and,
3	WHEREAS, The Parking and Traffic Commission at its meeting of December 18,
4	2001, adopted Resolution No. 178-01-PTC, urging the Board of Supervisors to Award the
5	Management Agreement for the Golden Gateway Garage to Five Star Parking/Elite Parking,
6	Joint Venture; and,
7	WHEREAS, Five Star Parking/Elite Parking, Joint Venture submitted the lowest
8	responsive and responsible bid for the management of the Golden Gateway Garage; and,
9	WHEREAS, The Parking and Traffic Commission at its meeting of December 18,
10	2001, adopted Resolution No. 178-01-PTC, urging the Board of Supervisors to Award the
11	Management Agreement for the Golden Gateway Garage to Five Star Parking/Elite Parking,
12	Joint Venture; and,
13	WHEREAS, On file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No.
14	, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully
15	herein; now, therefore be it
16	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves the award of the Golden
17	Gateway Garage to Five Star Parking/Elite Parking, Joint Venture; and, be it
18	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the
19	Management Agreement as in substantial form as approved by the City Attorney, with such
20	changes, addition, modification, or deletions as the Director of the Parking Authority or
21	designee may approve upon consultation with the City Attorney.
