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Resolution restating the automatic public toilet and public service kiosk agreement between the City and County of San Francisco and JC Decaux San Francisco, Inc. which allows for the expansion of the automatic toilet program beyond the trial phase and forwarding several other recommendations in order to ensure maximum quality and public safety of said contract agreement and forwarded recommendations.

WHEREAS, On August 2, 1994, the City and Contractor entered into an original agreement entitled Automatic Public Toilet and Public Service Kiosk Agreement; and

WHEREAS, The Contractor, JC DeCaux San Francisco, Inc. agreed to provide Automatic Public Toilets in exchange for the right to place Public Service Kiosks on public property and to sell advertising on said Public Service Kiosks subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Original Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, On August 24<sup>th</sup>, 2001, the Audit, Labor and Government Efficiency Committee held a hearing on said contract where several members of the public gave comment on public health and safety issues surrounding these toilets; and,

WHEREAS, The following recommendations were introduced, discussed and considered, including a request for the Department of Public Works (DPW) and the City Attorney to review the terms of the current Contract Agreement and conduct an assessment in order to determine if JC Decaux San Francisco, Inc. is in compliance with the contract provisions set forth, including but not limited to:

- The requirement to maintain the Automatic Public Toilets in a clean, graffiti-free, safe and first-class condition,
- Maintenance and inspection schedule, including hours of operations,

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- Contributions to public art kiosks,
- Interactive media kiosks and additional public service kiosks,
- Payments, including percentage revenues,
- Other public services; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Police Department (SFPD) shall commit to the increase of police presence and enforcement at all problem Automatic Public Toilet sites; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That JC Decaux will increase the number of staff to mitigate existing operational concerns of said toilets; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPW shall meet with the SFPD to jointly report back on conditions of the Automatic Public Toilets and action be take to improve the condition in and around the following sites:

- 1. 16th and Mission Streets,
- 2. Market and Powell Streets,
- 3. 6th and Mission Streets and
- 4. Larkin and 6<sup>th</sup> Streets; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby request that the City and Contractor negotiate in good faith, a contract modification to said agreement in order to negotiate an amendment to Section 2.014(c) to extend the current compliance date of July 2002 that would allow the City time to increase the number of Automatic Public Toilets beyond the current twenty-five pursuant to contract restrictions.
