[Changing the Street	Name of Edinburg	Street to Edinburgh	Street]
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Resolution authorizing a street name change of Edinburg Street to Edinburgh Street, to correct a spelling discrepancy and eliminate confusion in the delivery of public services.

WHEREAS, Residents have brought to the City's attention a discrepancy in the official and commonly used spelling of Edinburg Street in the Excelsior neighborhood; and,

WHEREAS, Surrounding streets in the Excelsior neighborhood are named after prominent international cities, such as London, Paris, Lisbon, Madrid, Naples, Vienna, Athens, Moscow, Munich, Prague, and Dublin; and,

WHEREAS, The correct spelling of the capital city of Scotland is Edinburgh; and, WHEREAS. Requiring the use of the official street name of Edinburg could trigger changes to postal services, GPS mapping services, public outreach, and could lead to confusion and disruptions to mail and billing services and other inconveniences in public services; and,

WHEREAS, Street signs currently in place already read "Edinburgh," therefore a spelling correction would not require the replacement of street signs; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That consistent with Public Works Code Sections 423, California Government Code Section 34091.1 and California Streets and Highways Code Sections 970.5 and 5026, the San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby changes the Edinburg Street to "Edinburgh Street" to correct a spelling discrepancy; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That by adopting this legislation, the Board of Supervisors does not intend to effectuate any change in City department jurisdictional control over any portion of Edinburg Street to be known as Edinburgh Street; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board to forward a copy of this Resolution to the County Surveyor in accordance with California Streets and Highways Code Section 5026.
