URGING MUNI TO EXTEND ITS REGULAR TRANSIT SERVICE TO TREASURE ISLAND

WHEREAS, On August 3, 1998, a Board of Supervisors Resolution was introduced urging the Mayor's Office and the Treasure Island Authority to authorize a request by The Alliance for Preserving the Truth of Sino-Japanese War to extend "The Forgotten Holocaust of World War II" photographic and video exhibit, on display at Treasure Island since July 5, 1998, through 1999; and

WHEREAS, There is currently no public transportation service from San Francisco to Treasure Island on Sundays; and

WHEREAS, Many San Franciscans who wish to see "The Forgotten Holocaust of World War II" exhibit rely on Muni as their sole means of transportation; and

WHEREAS, The opportunity to view this historically important exhibit should be made available to everyone, including those who lack transportation options; and

WHEREAS, The exhibit is a valuable educational resource containing the most comprehensive collection of visual historic documents of World War II in Asia and should be made available to anyone who wishes to learn more about "The Forgotten Holocaust"; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges Muni to extend its regular transit service to Treasure Island to include Sundays in order to provide the public with transportation to "The Forgotten Holocaust of World War II" exhibit on Treasure Island.
