

1 [Appointment, Public Utilities Revenue Bond Oversight Committee - Tim Cronin]

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3 **Motion appointing Tim Cronin (residency requirement waived), term ending November**
4 **12, 2020, to the Public Utilities Revenue Bond Oversight Committee.**

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6 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does
7 hereby appoint the hereinafter designated person to serve as a member of the Public Utilities
8 Revenue Bond Oversight Committee, pursuant to the provisions of the San Francisco
9 Administrative Code, Section 5.30-5.36, for the term specified:

10 Time Cronin (residency requirement waived), seat 2, succeeding themselves, must have
11 expertise, skills and experience in economics, the environment, construction or project
12 management, for the unexpired portion of a four-year term ending November 12, 2020; and,
13 be it

14 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 15 1. The membership of the Public Utilities Revenue Bond Oversight Committee has a goal
16 to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- 17 2. Applicant Tim Cronin, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with
18 experience that uniquely qualifies them to serve on the Public Utilities Revenue Bond
19 Oversight Committee.
- 20 3. The Public Utilities Revenue Bond Oversight Committee has attempted to fill the
21 position, for which Tim Cronin was nominated, with an individual who is City a resident
22 and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to
23 do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Tim Cronin is qualified to
24 serve on the Public Utilities Revenue Bond Oversight Committee.

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1 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no
2 other possible representatives, who is a resident of San Francisco, and who has the
3 specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is
4 willing to serve on the Public Utilities Revenue Bond Oversight Committee at this time;
5 and, be it

6 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement
7 for Tim Cronin, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be
8 found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101(a)(2), that requires person(s) appointed to boards,
9 commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors
10 to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.

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
