3 **Resolution authorizing the General Manager of the San Francisco Public Utilities**  
4 **Commission to apply for, accept and expend retroactively grants amounting to \$230,000 from the**  
5 **United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) for vulnerability assessment.**

7 WHEREAS, United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) provides grants  
8 for the SFPUC to develop vulnerability assessments, emergency operations plans and  
9 enhanced security measures for the SFPUC San Francisco and Regional water systems; and

10 WHEREAS, the SFPUC qualifies for grants for both its San Francisco and Regional  
11 water systems each providing water for 100,000 customers or more; and,

12 WHEREAS, This project will provide fundamental information for the protection of the  
13 SFPUC water systems; and,

14 WHEREAS, as part of SFPUC Security Program, the grant will subsidize the security  
15 efforts toward protecting and reducing risks to the water system from possible attack; and

16 WHEREAS, SFPUC will provide project oversight and grant administration for this  
17 project; now, therefore, be it

18 **RESOLVED**, that the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the General Manager to  
19 apply for, accept and expend retroactively grants amounting to \$230,000 from the United States  
20 Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA).


