ongoing efforts to improve air quality; and


WHEREAS, An apply for, accept, and expend resolution is required by the California Energy Commission; and

WHEREAS, Indirect costs were not requested in order to maximize project support; now therefore be it



FURTHER RESOLVED, That indirect cost are waived.






