Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Planning Department to apply for planning grants from the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans).

WHEREAS, The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) issues a call for applications for Transportation Planning Grants; and

WHEREAS, Transportation Planning Grants are intended to promote a balanced, comprehensive, multi-modal transportation system; and

WHEREAS, The Transit First policy and the Complete Street Ordinance align with the goals of the Transportation Planning Grants policies; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco is eligible to receive Federal and/or State funding for certain transportation planning related plans through the California Department of Transportation; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Director of the Planning Department, or a designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City and County of San Francisco all necessary applications, contracts, payment requests, and amendments hereto for the purpose of securing grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in the grant application; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco authorizes the submittal of an annual grant application or applications by the Planning Department to Caltrans for all available Transportation Planning Grant programs; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution shall remain in effect through calendar year 2014.
