

1 [Child Support Assurance]  
2 AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES AND THE DISTRICT  
3 ATTORNEY'S FAMILY SUPPORT BUREAU TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE  
4 CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES FOR A THREE YEAR  
5 DEMONSTRATION PROJECT TO DETERMINE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF CHILD  
6 SUPPORT ASSURANCE AS AN ALTERNATIVE TO, AND EXIT FROM, WELFARE.

7 WHEREAS, Child Support Assurance Demonstration Projects in other states have  
8 shown mixed results in their effectiveness as an exit from traditional welfare; and

9 WHEREAS, The California Welfare Reform Act of 1996 (CalWORKS) authorizes  
10 Counties to enter into demonstration projects on Child Support Assurance; and

11 WHEREAS, The Mayor's Welfare Reform Task Force, Community Meetings and  
12 recipient focus groups recommended that San Francisco enter into a demonstration project  
13 for Child Support Assurance as a part of our County Plan; and

14 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors approved the Mayor's Welfare Reform Task  
15 Force recommendations and the County Plan; and

16 WHEREAS, The Department of Human Services responded to the California  
17 Department of Social Services' Request for proposals and received preliminary approval to  
18 participate in the Child Support Assurance Demonstration project; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby requests the  
20 Director of the California Department of Social Services approve San Francisco's Child  
21 Support Assurance Demonstration Project, and, therefore, be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Executive  
23 Director of the Department of Human Services and the District Attorney to enter into any  
24 necessary agreements to implement San Francisco's Child Support Assurance Demonstration  
25 Project.




