

1 [Grant funds to support HIV/AIDS treatment and prevention services.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept**  
4 **and expend a new grant in the amount of \$1,244,866 from the Department of Health &**  
5 **Human Services - Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (DHHS-CMS) to support a**  
6 **project entitled “Improving HIV/AIDS Treatment and Prevention Services;” for the**  
7 **period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009.**

9 WHEREAS, DPH was awarded \$1,244,866 from DHHS-CMS’ Office of Research,  
10 Development and Information to support HIV/AIDS treatment and prevention services, for the  
11 period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009; and,

12 WHEREAS, These funds will allow DPH’s HIV Health Services section to support a  
13 series of interventions that will extend the benefits of HIV care and treatment to at least 650  
14 low-income individuals and families who are currently underserved; and,

15 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required, as this grant funds existing positions  
16 only, including Assistant Director of Clinical Services II (Job Class #2248) at .10 FTE, Health  
17 Program Coordinator III (Job Class #2593) at .50 FTE, and Administrative Analyst (Job Class  
18 #1822) at .50 FTE; and,

19 WHEREAS, This funding opportunity is non-competitive and restricted to a limited  
20 number of organizations, including San Francisco’s DPH, that were identified and specifically  
21 designated by Congress; and,

22 WHEREAS, The source of the one percent (\$12,499) matching requirement for this  
23 grant is DPH’s HIV Health Services general fund; and,

24 WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$17,694; now,  
25 therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant from DHHS-  
2 CMS' Office of Research, Development and Information in the amount of \$1,244,866; and, be  
3 it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the  
5 grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions  
7 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when  
8 the agreement expires.
