16	behavioral health crisis stabilization, residential, outpatient, therapeutic, diversion, school-

20	Health and the Director of the Office of Contract Administration/Purchaser, on behalf of the
21	City and County of San Francisco, to execute Amendment No. 1 to the agreement with
22	Edgewood Center for Children and Families for behavioral health services for an amount not
23	to exceed \$57,298,967 for a total agreement term of July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2027;

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1	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Department of
2	Public Health to enter into any amendments or modifications to the contract, prior to its final
3	execution by all parties, that the Department determines, in consultation with the City

5	obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of
6	the contract, and are in compliance with all applicable laws; and, be it
