WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco will hold a municipal election on November 5, 2024, for the purpose of voting on candidates for local office and proposed local ballot measures to be submitted to the voters: and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors has called a special election to be held in the City and County of San Francisco on November 5, 2024, for the purpose of voting on a proposed general obligation bond measure, and a consolidated special municipal bond measure election with the State of California General Election scheduled for the same date;

The consolidation of elections allows the Department of Elections to conduct all elections in a manner as though the Department were to conduct only one election.


