12 does not encourage workfare workers to obtain permanent positions in the City; now,
13 therefore, be it

14 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
15 hereby requests the Office of the Legislative Analyst to perform an analysis and make
16 recommendations on how the City's Civil Service System could be revised to enable
17 departments to provide permanent employment opportunities for workfare workers.


