Dear Ms. Calvillo,

Should the proposed ordinance be approved by the voters, in my opinion, it would have a minimal impact on the cost of government.

The proposed ordinance would require the City Administrator to prepare an annual report to enumerate federal laws or policies that the City has applied in a manner that discriminated against historically marginalized groups on the basis of race, ethnicity, sex, gender, sexual orientation, disability, national origin, citizenship or immigration status, or religious affiliation or nonaffiliation. City departments would be required annually to certify they have not used any City funds or resources to assist in the enforcement or implementation of any federal laws or policies identified in the City Administrator's report, or to submit a report explaining how and why they have used City funds to provide such assistance.
