[City Hall Child Care Facility License Agreement] AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING A LICENSE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND

COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO, AS LICENSOR, AND MARIN DAY SCHOOLS, AS

LICENSEE. FOR A CHILD CARE FACILITY LOCATED ON THE GROUND FLOOR LEVEL OF CITY HALL AND AT AN ADDITIONAL OUTDOOR FACILITY AREA.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

The Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco (the Section 1. "Board") hereby makes the following findings:

- Α. City desires to have a child care center at City Hall in operation by July of 1999.
- B. City has entered into a grant agreement with Marin Day Schools in which the City provides an annual grant to subsidize child care operation costs ("Operation Grant").
- C. City, as licensor, and Marin Day School, as licensee, desire to enter into a license agreement substantially in the form of the license agreement filed with the Clerk of the Board in File No. 990880 (the "License Agreement"), for the spaces located on the ground floor level of City Hall and at an additional outdoor facility area (collectively, the "Child Care Facility").
- D. The License Agreement is for an initial term commencing on July 1, 1999, and expiring on June 30, 2002, and the Director of Property, on behalf of the City, may extend the License Agreement beyond the initial term should the Operation Grant be extended.
- E. Under the License Agreement, Marin Day Schools shall pay to City a license fee of one dollar per year.
- F. Under the License Agreement, City shall provide utilities, janitorial and maintenance services for the Child Care Facility.

Section 2. In accordance with the recommendation of the Director of Administrative Services and the Director of Property, the Board hereby authorizes the Director of Property. on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, to enter into the License Agreement with Marin Day Schools.

Section 3. The Board authorizes the Director of Property to enter into any additions. amendments or other modifications to the License Agreement (including, without limitation, the exhibits) that the Director of Property determines, in consultation with the City Attorney, are in the best interests of the City, do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, and are necessary or advisable to complete the transaction contemplated in the License Agreement and effectuate the purpose and intent of this ordinance, such determination to be conclusively evidenced by the execution and delivery by the Director of Property of any amendments thereto.

All actions taken by the Director of Property and other relevant officers of Section 4. the City with respect to the License Agreement are hereby approved, confirmed and ratified.
