9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in
11 this Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California
12 Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of
13 the Board of Supervisors in File No. _____ and is incorporated herein by reference.

14 Section 2. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby amended
15 by amending Section 1237, to read as follows:

16 **SEC. 1237. FEES.**

17 (a) The Director is authorized to charge the following fees to defray the costs of
18 document processing and review, consultation with applicants, and administration of this
19 Article: (1) an initial fee of ~~\$390~~\$501, payable to the Department, upon filing a site history
20 report with the Department; and (2) an additional fee of ~~\$130~~\$167 per hour for document
21 processing and review and applicant consultation exceeding three hours or portion thereof,
22 payable to the Department, upon filing of the certification required pursuant to Section 1229.

23 (b) Beginning with fiscal year 2008-2009 and annually thereafter, the fees set forth in this
24 Section may be adjusted each year, without further action by the Board of Supervisors, as set forth in
25 this Section.


1 Not later than April 1 , the Director shall report to the Controller the revenues generated by the
2 fees for the prior fiscal year and the prior fiscal year's costs of operation, as well as any other
3 information that the Controller determines appropriate to the performance of the duties set forth in this
4 Section.

5 Not later than May 15, the Controller shall determine whether the current fees have produced
6 or are projected to produce revenues sufficient to support the costs of providing the services for which
7 the fees are assessed and that the fees will not produce revenue which is significantly more than the
8 costs of providing the services for which the fees are assessed.

9 The Controller shall, if necessary, adjust the fees upward or downward for the upcoming fiscal
10 year as appropriate to ensure that the program recovers the costs of operation without producing
11 revenue which is significantly more than such costs. The adjusted rates shall become operative on July

12 I.
