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## [MAJOR NARCOTICS GRANT - STATE FUNDS]

RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING/THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND EXPEND FUNDS MADE AVAILABLE THROUGH THE OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE PLANNING FOR A PROJECT ENTITLED "SAN FRANCISCO DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE MAJOR NARCOTIC VENDORS PROSECUTION PROGRAM", AND WAIVING INDIRECT COSTS DUE TO FUNDING CONSTRAINTS.

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco desires to continue a certain project designated the Major Narcotic Vendors Prosecution Program to be funded in part from funds made available in accordance with the statutory effort to support enhanced prosecution efforts, Penal Code Section 13882(b) administered by the Office of Criminal Justice Planning (hereafter "OCJP"); now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the District Attorney of the City and County of San Francisco is authorized to apply for, accept, and expend funds for the purpose of implementing the Major Narcotic Vendors Prosecution Program from OCJP; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized to execute on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Award Agreements for Major Narcotic Vendor Prosecution purposes including any extensions, funding augmentations or amendments thereof; and,

IT IS AGREED. That there are no matching funds required for said project under the Major Narcotic Vendor Prosecution Program and the rules and regulations of OCJP; and,

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IT IS AGREED, That any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant Award Agreements, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and OCJP disclaim responsibility for any such liability; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
