7	Department of Parking and Traffic is hereby authorized and directed to cause "STOP" or "YIELD" signs to be installed thereat as designated below:
8	TIELD Signs to be installed increat as designated below.
9	STOP SIGNS - ESTABLISH
10	19th Street and Rhode Island Street, stopping 19th Street at Rhode Island Street, making this uncontrolled T-intersection a One-Way STOP.
11	Leese Street and Richland Avenue, stopping Richard Avenue at Lesse Street, making this an All-Way STOP.
12	
13 14	28th Avenue and Lake Street, stopping the northern intersection of 28th Avenue at Lake Street, making this intersection an All-Way STOP.
15	YIELD SIGN – ESTABLISH
16	San Bruno Avenue, southbound, merging onto Bayshore Boulevard, south of Arleta Avenue.
17	
18	Categorically exempt from Environmental Review Class
19	1(c)(9) changes in the traffic and parking regulations where such changes do not establish a higher speed
20	limit or result in more than a negligible increase in the use of the street.
