13 and enjoyed the two free concerts featuring performances by Kei Lun  
14 Martial Arts, the White Crane Lion Dance Association, Kulintang Arts  
15 Heritage Program, Melody of China, Pinay, Hanmadung Korean Youth  
16 Cultural Center Drumming Group, the California Chinese Orchestra, Eva  
17 Tam, Vinroc, the Asian American Jazz Orchestra, and Genny Lim; and,

18 WHEREAS, Through cultural and artistic performance, this event  
19 celebrated the heritage and history of Asian Pacific Americans and  
20 commemorated the many achievements of the community; and,

21 WHEREAS, These performances were coordinated under the direction  
22 of Asian Improv Arts now, therefore, be it


