4	Resolution approving and authorizing the execution of Lease No. GS-09B-02006 with
5	the United States of America for office space to be occupied by the Transportation
6	Security Administration, a Federal agency, in the International Terminal of San
7	Francisco International Airport.
8	WHEREAS, on November 19, 2001, the Federal government passed the Aviation and
9	Transportation Security Act, thereby creating the Transportation Security Administration
10	("TSA"); and
11	WHEREAS, the TSA is responsible for ensuring aviation security at all U.S. airports,
12	including San Francisco International Airport (the "Airport"); and
13	WHEREAS, the TSA currently occupies office space in the International Terminal of the
	Airport under Lease No. GS-09B-01526 pursuant to Airport Commission Resolution No. 03-
14	0126, adopted on June 25, 2003 and Board of Supervisors' Resolution No. 543-03, adopted
15	on August 22, 2003; and
16	WHEREAS, the aforementioned lease terminates on October 31, 2007 and the TSA
17	wishes to enter into a new lease with a term of five (5) years effective November 1, 2007; and
18	WHEREAS, Airport staff has negotiated a renewal lease with the United States of
19	America for 7,200 square feet of office space, to be occupied by the TSA, with a term of five
20	(5) years; and
	WHEREAS, on August 21, 2007, pursuant to Resolution No. 07-0195, the Airport
21	Commission approved Lease No. GS-09B-02006 (the "Lease") with the United States of
22	America; and
23	WHEREAS, a copy of the form of the Lease is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
24	Supervisors in File No. <u>071461</u> , which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if
25	set forth fully herein; now, therefore, be it

1	RESOLVED, that this Board of Supervisors hereby approves and authorizes the
	execution of Lease No. GS-09B-02006 for space in the International Terminal of the Airport
2	retroactive to November 1, 2007, between the United States of America, and the City and
3	County of San Francisco, acting by and through its Airport Commission.
