8 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

9 Section 1. Findings.

10 The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this  
 11 Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public  
 12 Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the  
 13 Board of Supervisors in File No. \_\_\_\_\_ and is incorporated herein by reference.

14 Section 2. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by amending Section  
 15 12.22, to read as follows:

16 **SEC. 12.22. EVENTS.**

17 The following fees shall be charged for use of the parks for events:

18 *(a) Commercial Events per day:*

22 Year (FY) 2008-2009; 35% of the Commercial Fee in FY 2009-2010, and 50% of the Commercial Fee  
23 in FY 2010-2011 and thereafter.

1 (b) Gated Events – Applicable venue permit fee or 25% of the gate receipts, whichever is  
 2 greater.

3 (c) Elementary, Middle or High School Outdoor Events, including sports field days:

4 (1)	Four hours or less	\$100
5 (2)	Each additional hour	\$25

6 (d) Athletic events charging participants an entry fee, per day:

7 (1)	<i>1,000 participants or less</i>	<i>\$400</i>
8 (2)	<i>For each participant over 1,000</i>	<i>\$1.00</i>

9 (e) Athletic events not charging participants an entry fee, per day:

10 (1)	<i>500 participants or less</i>	<i>\$250</i>
11 (2)	<i>Each additional 500 participants, or portion thereof</i>	<i>\$100</i>

13 (d) Athletic Events requiring a road closure – \$1.00 per participant.

14 (e) Concession Fee – An amount equal to 5% of the gross sales receipts as determined by sales  
 15 tax documentation that is provided by the Permittee to the California State Board of Equalization to be  
 16 paid within 30 days following the event.

17 (f) Amateur Productions of performing arts, no charge to the public:

18 (1)	Weekdays (Monday – Friday)	\$150 per day
19 (2)	Weekdays, two consecutive days at same site	\$250 / two days
20 (3)	Non-holiday weekends	\$200 per day
21 (4)	Non-holiday weekends, two consecutive days, same site	\$350 / two days
22 (5)	Holiday weekends, two consecutive days, same site	\$500 / two days

2           and/ or services, the disruption of normal park usage and the inconvenience to the public, because of  
3           the type of event, the location, the number of expected participants and other similar factors.
