1	[Resolution Urging MTA to approve temporary "Street Closure to Vehicular Traffic" on
2	O'Farrell St. between Steiner and Fillmore for Farmers' Market]

4	Resolution urging the Municipal Transportation Authority to enact temporary "Street
5	Closure to Vehicular Traffic" regulations on O'Farrell Street between Steiner Street and
6	Fillmore Street from 7 A.M. to 2 P.M. on every Saturday between April 26, 2008 and
7	November 22, 2008.

9	WHEREAS, Over the last five years the Fillmore Farmers' Market drew an average of
10	1,000 customers to each market, drawing over 28,000 shoppers to the Fillmore District in
11	2007; and,
12	WHEREAS, Studies show that low-income communities and communities of color
13	such as the Fillmore suffer from the lack of access to healthy food including fresh produce;
14	and,
15	WHEREAS, Farmers' markets are one means to address the lack of access to healthy,
16	nutritious food, including fresh and organic fruits and vegetables at reasonable prices; and,
17	WHEREAS, Fast food outlets and corner stores are often a primary local food source
18	available to residents in the community; and,
19	WHEREAS, Fast food and food commonly purchased at corner stores is typically high
20	in fat content; and,
21	WHEREAS, High fat diets are associated with an increased risk of obesity, heart
22	disease, diabetes mellitus, some types of cancer, and other health problems; and,
23	WHEREAS, The Fillmore Saturday Farmers' Market accepts EBT (food stamps),
24	Senior and WIC coupons, ensuring that the market is accessible to lower income shoppers;

1	WHEREAS, Farmers' markets provide an opportunity for consumers to interact directly
2	with the people in the region who grow the food and for farmers to learn more about what
3	their customers want; and,
4	WHEREAS, Food sold and purchased at farmers' markets travels a shorter distance
5	from field to table than most food in the grocery store thus saving fuel and helping to protect
6	the environment; and,
7	WHEREAS, The Sustainability Plan for the City and County of San Francisco, adopted
8	by the Board of Supervisors in 1997, lists access to nutritious, affordable, and safe food as a
9	principal goal; and,
10	WHEREAS, The Sustainability Plan identifies creating farmers' markets in every
11	neighborhood in San Francisco as a long-term objective; and,
12	WHEREAS, The Fillmore Farmers' Market provides residents with access to fruits and
13	vegetables that will help Fillmore families meet their nutritional needs; and,
14	WHEREAS, San Francisco Traffic Code sections 803, 804, 805, and 807 sets forth the
15	procedure for temporary street closures; now, therefore, be it
16	
17	RESOLVED, the Board of Supervisors urges the MTA to approve a temporary "Street
18	Closure to Vehicular Traffic" regulation on O'Farrell Street between Steiner Street and
19	Fillmore Street from 7 A.M. to 2 P.M. on every Saturday between April 26, 2008 and
20	November 22, 2008.
