2 **DESIGNATING THE FIREBOAT HOUSE, PIER 22 1/2, AS LANDMARK NO. 225 PURSUANT TO**  
3 **ARTICLE 10, SECTIONS 1004 AND 1004.4, OF THE PLANNING CODE.**

4 Be it ordained by the people of the City and County of San Francisco:

5  
6 Section 1. The Board of Supervisors hereby finds that The Fireboat House at Pier 22 1/2,  
7 on the east side of The Embarcadero on Lot 22 1/2 in Assessor's Block 9900, has a  
8 special character and special historical, architectural and aesthetic interest and value, and  
9 that its designation as a Landmark will further the purposes of, and conform to the  
10 standards set forth in Article 10 of the City Planning Code.

11  
12 (a) Designation: Pursuant to Section 1004 of the City Planning Code, Chapter II, Part II of  
13 the San Francisco Municipal Code, The Fireboat House at Pier 22 1/2, is hereby  
14 designated as Landmark No. 225. This designation has been fully approved by Resolution  
15 No. 14775 of the Planning Commission, which Resolution is on file with the Clerk of the  
16 Board of Supervisors under File No. 990430 and which Resolution is incorporated  
17 herein and made part hereof as though fully set forth.

19 (b) Required Data:

21 (1) The description, location and boundary of the Landmark site is Lot 22 1/2 in  
22 Assessor's Block 9900.
- 23 (2) The characteristics of the Landmark which justify its designation are  
24 described and shown in the Landmark Designation Report adopted by the  
25 Landmarks Preservation Advisory Board on November 18, 1998 and other

1 supporting materials contained in Planning Department Docket No.  
2 1998.912L.

- 3 (3) That the particular exterior features that should be preserved, or replaced  
4 in-kind as determined necessary are those generally described in the  
5 Landmark Designation Report adopted by the Landmarks Preservation  
6 Advisory Board on November 18, 1998 on File in Planning Department  
7 Docket No. 1998.912L, and Planning Commission Resolution No. 14775,  
8 both of which are incorporated in this designation ordinance as though fully  
9 set forth.




