WHEREAS, a collaborative of community advocates, community based organizations, the San Francisco Department of Public Health, the San Francisco Unified School District and community hospitals have consistently met to research and develop programs to implement the best practices for asthmatics living in San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, the creation of a formal citywide Asthma Task Force and the "Optimal Management of Asthma in the Community" forum is a direct result of their collaborative efforts that will further promote the health and well-being of San Francisco residents; and,

WHEREAS, in San Francisco, the forum will provide agencies and individuals serving people with asthma information and the direct interaction with physicians, environmental experts and representatives from community based organization; now, therefore, be it
