WHEREAS, Two of the homeless people who died in San Francisco in 2000 were a 12 day-old girl and a 6 weeks-old boy; and,

WHEREAS, Religious Witness with Homeless People is organizing a broad-based Community Memorial Service to be held at 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, March 11, 2001 to commemorate the tragedy of 138 homeless deaths in our community in 2000; now, therefore, be it
