2 Resolution Remembering the hundreds of individuals who died  
3 homeless in our community over the years and declaring March 11,  
4 2001 "A day of love and sorrow, remembering the 138 men, women,  
5 and children who died homeless in San Francisco in 2000."

7 WHEREAS, At least 100 homeless people have died in San  
8 Francisco each year since 1987; and,

9 WHEREAS, 138 homeless individuals died on San Francisco  
10 streets in 2000; and,

11 WHEREAS, Over the past 14 years since such records have  
12 been kept, at least 1,767 people have died homeless in our City;  
13 and,

14 WHEREAS, The average life expectancy in the United States  
15 is 76.1 years, and the average age of homeless individuals who  
16 died in San Francisco is 43.6 years; and,

17 WHEREAS, Two of the homeless people who died in San  
18 Francisco in 2000 were a 12 day-old girl and a 6 weeks-old boy;  
19 and,

20 WHEREAS, Religious Witness with Homeless People is  
21 organizing a broad-based Community Memorial Service to be held  
22 at 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, March 11, 2001 to commemorate the  
23 tragedy of 138 homeless deaths in our community in 2000; now,




