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AUTHORIZING THE RECREATION AND PARK DEPARTMENT TO APPLY, ACCEPT AND EXPEND A \$541,750 GRANT FOR THE CHINESE RECREATION CENTER; A \$2,462,500 GRANT FOR THE CONSERVATORY OF FLOWERS RESTORATION; A \$492,500 GRANT FOR THE MARGARET HAYWARD CLUBHOUSE RENOVATION; A \$492,500 GRANT FOR THE VISITACION VALLEY REIS TRACT-CAMPBELL AND RUTLAND MINI PARK AND COMMUNITY GARDENS AND GREENWAY; AND A \$1,083,500 GRANT FOR NORTH MISSION OPEN SPACE, ALL RECEIVED FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA GENERAL FUND DURING FISCAL YEAR 1999-00;

PLACING \$514,000 ON RESERVE.

WHEREAS, The Legislature and Governor of the State of California have approved grants for the project shown above; and,

WHEREAS, The State Department of Parks and Recreation has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of these grant projects, setting up necessary procedures; and,

WHEREAS, Said procedures established by the State Department of Parks and Recreation require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of application for the above projects before submission of said application to the state; and,

WHEREAS, Indirect costs are not allowed by the funder; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby:

1. Approves the application, acceptance and expenditure of \$541,750 for the Chinese Recreation Center; \$2,462,500 for the Conservatory

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of Flowers Restoration; \$492,500 for the Margaret Hayward Clubhouse renovation; \$492,500 for the Visitacion Valley Reis Tract - Campbell and Rutland Mini Park and Community Gardens and Greenway; and \$1,083,500 for North Mission Open Space;

- 2. Certifies that the City and County of San Francisco Recreation and Park Department is in accordance with the general provisions of the agreement with the State of California;
- 3. Certifies that the City and County of San Francisco has sufficient funds to operate and maintain the projects funded under this program;
- 4. Certifies that said agency has reviewed and understands the General Provision contained in the State/local agreement shown in the Procedural Guide;
- 5. Appoints the General Manager or Acting General Manager as agent of the Recreation and Park Department to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned projects; and
- 6. Waives indirect costs as they are not allowed by the funder; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds designated for the Chinese Recreation Center Project, in the amount of \$514,000 shall be placed on reserve, pending submission of the final project scope and budget, to be released by the Parks and Recreation Committee.
