8 **Year 2007-2008 and reserving the funds pending review of expenditure plans by the**  
9 **Budget and Finance Committee.**

22 Section 3. The Mayor's Office of Housing shall administer the uses of funding for the  
 23 affordable housing programs. Prior to expending any portion of these funds, the Mayor's  
 24 Office of Housing shall present a plan for review by the Board of Supervisors. By December  
 25 6, 2007, and every six months thereafter until the appropriation is fully expended, the Mayor's

1 Office of Housing shall report to the Board of Supervisors on the uses of these funds toward  
2 the development of affordable housing.

4 Section 4. The total appropriation of \$5,000,000 for Supportive Housing programs is reserved  
5 pending review of the expenditure plans by the Board of Supervisors Budget and Finance  
6 Committee.
