WHEREAS, The purpose of the Heritage Program is to support firefighters for safer communities; and


WHEREAS, The Fire Department's intent for the use of these funds is to develop a recruitment video for the Department in its outreach efforts; now, therefore, be it

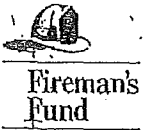
