3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of Environment to retroactively accept and**
4 **expend a grant in the amount of \$450,330 from the State Department of Conservation**
5 **(DOC) for Fiscal Year 2002/2003.**

7 WHEREAS, Recycling conserves resources and is necessary to achieve the state
8 mandated goal of 50% waste diversion by the end of year 2000; and,

9 WHEREAS, The Commission on the Environment passed a resolution supporting
10 adoption of a 75% diversion goal by 2010 and Zero Waste by 2020; and,

11 WHEREAS, The Department of the Environment established the Solid Waste
12 Management Program, which manages the Curbside Program and other beverage container
13 recycling programs; and,

14 WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 14581 (a)(4)(A) of the California Public Resources
15 Code, the DOC is required to make annual payments to eligible cities and counties that
16 submit the necessary forms; and,

17 WHEREAS, Pursuant to Administrative Code Section 10.170-1(c), the Department of
18 Environment's approved 2002/2003 budget includes the DOC payment in the amount of
19 \$450,330, but to date no grant funds have been expended; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves retroactively the acceptance of
21 the grant and approves the expenditure of grant funds; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of the Environment is authorized to
23 receive similar annually recurring payments from the DOC following the same procedures;
24 and be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of the Environment may use a portion of
2 this funding to create a grant funded position; and be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of the Environment Director is hereby
4 authorized and empowered to execute all necessary forms for the purpose of securing
5 payments and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in Section 14581 (a)(4)(A) of
6 the California Public Resources Code.
