8 WHEREAS, In 1997, as a sign of this commitment to reducing the use of pesticides, the
9 City and County of San Francisco adopted the landmark Integrated Pest Management (IPM)
10 Ordinance; and,

11 WHEREAS, San Francisco's County Agricultural Commissioner, David C. Frieders, was
12 instrumental in the development of the IPM Ordinance and the key first years of implementation
13 of the City and County's IPM Program; and,

14 WHEREAS, Agricultural Commissioner David C. Frieders crafted an effective
15 and comprehensive pest management plan for the Department of Agriculture and all other
16 departments in the City and County of San Francisco; and,

17 WHEREAS, He worked closely with environmental organizations, businesses and
18 municipalities across the country to encourage the proliferation of pesticide reduction
19 programs; and,

20 WHEREAS, By implementing the IPM Program, David C. Frieders provided
21 leadership by example for the County Agricultural Commissioners throughout California;




