

1 (STREET ARTISTS)
2 DESIGNATING SIX TEMPORARY SELLING SPACES ON POST STREET, NORTH
3 SIDE, AT GRANT AVENUE, FOR STREET ARTISTS CERTIFIED BY THE ARTS
4 COMMISSION, CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO; DESIGNATION
5 COMMENCING WITH DISPLACEMENT OF SIX PERMANENT SPACES ON GRANT
6 AVENUE, WEST SIDE, AT POST STREET, DUE TO SIDEWALK RECONSTRUCTION
7 ADJACENT TO SHREVE'S BUILDING; EXEMPTING FOUR OF SAID TEMPORARY
8 SPACES ON POST STREET, NORTH SIDE, AT GRANT AVENUE, FROM THE
9 PROVISIONS OF POLICE CODE SECTION 2405(C)(5), REQUIRING STREET
10 ARTISTS TO SELL NOT WITHIN SEVEN AND ONE-HALF FEET OF SPRINKLER
11 OR STANDPIPE INLETS; EXEMPTING THREE OF SAID TEMPORARY SPACES
12 ON POST STREET, NORTH SIDE, AT GRANT AVENUE, FROM THE PROVISIONS
13 OF POLICE CODE SECTION 2405(C)(6), REQUIRING STREET ARTISTS
14 TO SELL NOT WITHIN TWELVE FEET OF ANY BUILDING ENTRANCE;
15 EXEMPTING TWO OF SAID TEMPORARY SPACES ON POST STREET, NORTH
16 SIDE, AT GRANT AVENUE, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF POLICE CODE SECTION
17 2405(C)(16), REQUIRING STREET ARTISTS TO MAINTAIN ON THE PUBLIC
18 SIDEWALK A PASSAGE FOR PEDESTRIANS OF AT LEAST TEN FEET IN WIDTH;
19 AND EXEMPTING ONE OF SAID TEMPORARY SPACES ON POST STREET, NORTH
20 SIDE, AT GRANT AVENUE, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF POLICE CODE SECTION
21 2405(C)(8)(1), REQUIRING STREET ARTISTS TO SELL NOT ADJACENT
22 TO A CURB WHICH HAS BEEN DESIGNATED AS A WHITE ZONE; AND
23 TERMINATING SAID SIX TEMPORARY SPACES ON POST STREET, NORTH
24 SIDE, AT GRANT AVENUE, UPON COMPLETION OF SIDEWALK RECONSTRUCTION
25 OF GRANT AVENUE, WEST SIDE, AT POST STREET, ADJACENT TO SHREVE'S

1 BUILDING.

3 WHEREAS, The Street Artist Ordinance adopted by the voters
4 on November 4, 1975 authorizes the Board of Supervisors, by
5 resolution, to designate sales areas where any street artist
6 or craftsman previously certified may sell art or craft items;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, The six designated spaces on Grant Avenue, west
9 side, at Post Street, adjacent to Shreve's Building, have proven
10 to be prime selling locations for street artists for the past
11 twenty-four years; and

12 WHEREAS, The six designated spaces on Grant Avenue, west
13 side, at Post Street, adjacent to Shreve's Building, are
14 essential to the limited supply of spaces for street artists,
15 as a result of the elimination of spaces due to construction,
16 curb zone changes, newsracks, planter boxes, etc.; and

17 WHEREAS, The impending reconstruction of the sidewalk
18 of Grant Avenue, west side, at Post Street, adjacent to Shreve's
19 Building, will be requiring the closure of said sidewalk for
20 the duration of its reconstruction; and

21 WHEREAS, The closure of said sidewalk will eliminate
22 the six spaces for street artists; and

23 WHEREAS, The Arts Commission conducted a public hearing
24 to relocate three of the six spaces to the northwest sidewalk
25 of Post Street, north side, at Grant Avenue, and three of the

1 six spaces to the northeast sidewalk of Post Street, north side,
2 at Grant Avenue, for the duration of the reconstruction of the
3 sidewalk of Grant Avenue, west side, at Post Street; now,
4 therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby designates
6 for the duration of the reconstruction of the sidewalk of Grant
7 Avenue, west side, at Post Street, the following spaces for
8 street artists certified by the Arts Commission:

9 Spaces

10 6 - Post Street, north side, at Grant Avenue

11 and be it

12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the designation of the six (6)
13 temporary spaces on Post Street, north side, at Grant Avenue,
14 shall commence with the displacement of the six spaces on Grant
15 Avenue, west side, at Post Street; and be it

16 FURTHER RESOLVED, That four (4) of the six (6) temporary
17 spaces on Post Street, north side, at Grant Avenue, are exempt
18 from the provisions of Police Code Section 2405(c)(5), which
19 requires street artists to sell not within seven and one-half
20 ($7\frac{1}{2}$) feet of sprinkler or standpipe inlets; and be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED, That three (3) of the six (6) temporary
22 spaces on Post Street, north side, at Grant Avenue, are exempt
23 from the provisions of Police Code Section 2405(c)(6), which
24 requires street artists to sell not within twelve (12) feet
25 from the outer edge of any entrance to any building measured

1 in each direction parallel to the building line and thence at
2 a 90-degree angle to the curb; and be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That two (2) of the six (6) temporary
4 spaces on Post Street, north side, at Grant Avenue, are exempt
5 from the provisions of Police Code Section 2405(c)(16), which
6 requires street artists to maintain on the public sidewalks
7 a passage for pedestrians of at least ten (10) feet in width
8 as measured on a line perpendicular to the curb line, between
9 the edge of the sidewalk farthest from the curb and the edge
10 of the street artists' activities; and be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That one (1) of the six (6) temporary
12 spaces on Post Street, north side, at Grant Avenue, is exempt
13 from the provisions of Police Code Section 2405(c)(8)(1), which
14 requires street artists to no sell adjacent to a curb which
15 has been designated as a white zone; and be it

16 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the designation of the six (6)
17 temporary spaces on Post Street, north side, at Grant Avenue,
18 shall terminate upon completion of the sidewalk reconstruction
19 of, and restoration of the six (6) spaces on, Grant Avenue,
20 west side, at Post Street.

Resolution designating six temporary selling spaces on Post Street, north side, at Grant Avenue, for street artists certified by the Arts Commission, City and County of San Francisco; designation commencing with displacement of six permanent spaces on Grant Avenue, west side, at Post Street, due to sidewalk reconstruction adjacent to Shreve's Building; exempting four of said temporary spaces on Post Street, north side, at Grant Avenue, from the provisions of Police Code Section 2405(C) (5), requiring street artists to sell not within seven and one-half feet of sprinkler or standpipe inlets; exempting three of said temporary spaces on Post Street, north side, at Grant Avenue, from the provisions of Police Code Section 2405(C) (6), requiring street artists to sell not within twelve feet of any building entrance; exempting two of said temporary spaces on Post Street, north side, at Grant Avenue, from the provisions of Police Code Section 2405(C) (16), requiring street artists to maintain on the public sidewalk a passage for pedestrians of at least ten feet in width; and exempting one of said temporary spaces on Post Street, north side, at Grant Avenue, from the provisions of Police Code Section 2405(C) (8) (1), requiring street artists to sell not adjacent to a curb which has been designated as a white zone; and terminating said six temporary spaces on Post Street, north side, at Grant Avenue, upon completion of sidewalk reconstruction of Grant Avenue, west side, at Post Street, adjacent to Shreve's Building.




