

1 [Contracting out Laundry Services at Laguna Honda Hospital.]

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3 **Resolution concurring retroactively, with the Controller’s certification that the laundry**  
4 **services can be performed for the Department of Public Health, Laguna Honda Hospital**  
5 **by private contractor for a lower cost than similar work performed by City and County**  
6 **employees.**

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8 WHEREAS, The electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed  
9 Proposition J in November 1976, allowing City Departments to contract with private  
10 companies for specific services which can be performed for a lower cost than similar work by  
11 City and County employees (Charter Section 10.104.15); and

12 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health, Laguna Honda Hospital, will access a  
13 Purchaser’s awarded contract for these Laundry Services; and

14 WHEREAS, The Controller’s certification of July 3, 2002, confirms that said services  
15 can be performed at lower costs to the City and County by private contractor than by  
16 employees of the City and County, is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File  
17 No. , which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein  
18 now; therefore be it;

19 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby concurs retroactively with the  
20 Controller’s certification and approves the Proposition J Resolution for the period July 1, 2002  
21 through June 30, 2004.
