8 Streets, have previously been known as Unnamed Streets 110 and 111; and,

9 WHEREAS, It is in the best interest and safety of the residents and business owners in
10 the neighborhood for the alleys to be given a designated street name; and,

11 WHEREAS, Faye Goldberg, a feisty and kindhearted woman, was a beloved landlady
12 of several properties on Fillmore Street for many years and a wonderful neighbor to all; and

13 WHEREAS, Upon her death, Faye Goldberg left her entire estate, worth millions of
14 dollars, to charity; and,

15 WHEREAS, the residents and neighbors of the 2200 block of Fillmore Street would like
16 to honor this fine San Franciscan in a way worthy of her spirit; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the alleys between Fillmore and Webster Streets bordered
18 Sacramento and Clay Streets will now and forever be known as Goldberg Lane.


