2 to providers operating child-care facilities subject to Sections  
3 314.4(b)(1), (2), (3) and (5) to reduce the cost of providing  
4 affordable child-care services to children from households of low  
5 income as required in Section 314.4(i). The remaining monies  
6 deposited in the Fund during such three-year period, and all monies  
7 in the fund following expiration of such three-year period, shall be  
8 used solely to increase and/or improve the supply of child-care  
9 facilities affordable to households of low and moderate income;  
10 except that monies from the fund may be used by the Director to fund  
11 any report(s) required to demonstrate the relationship between office  
12 and hotel development projects and child care demand as described in  
13 San Francisco Planning Code Section 314.4. In the event that no  
14 child-care facility is in operation under Sections 314.4(b)(1), (2),  
15 (3) or (5) during ((the one-year)) such three-year period ((after the  
16 money is deposited into the Fund)), the maximum of 25 percent of the  
17 Fund reserved for households of low income shall be spent solely to  
18 increase and/or improve the supply of child-care facilities  
19 affordable to households of low and moderate income. The Fund shall  
20 be administered by the Director, who shall adopt rules and  
21 regulations governing the disposition of the Fund which are  
22 consistent with this Section. Such rules and regulations shall be  
23 subject to approval by resolution of the Board of Supervisors.  
24 ((Within one year after the effective date of this Section, the

1 circulation in San Francisco proposed rules and regulations and  
2 notice of a public hearing on such rules and regulations. The public  
3 hearing shall be held within 30 days, but not less than 10 days, from  
4 such notice. At the public hearing, the Director shall adopt final  
5 rules and regulations and submit the same to the Board of Supervisors  
6 forthwith. The Board of Supervisors shall hold a public hearing on  
7 the Director's final rules and regulations within 45 days of receipt  
8 from the Director, at which time the Board may amend such rules and  
9 regulations or adopt them in their entirety. Any further amendments  
10 to such rules and regulations shall be initiated by the Director and  
11 shall be adopted in accordance with the above procedure.))




