

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - President’s Emergency Plan for Aid - \$200,331]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health to accept and**
4 **expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$200,331 from the University of California**
5 **San Francisco to assist with a project entitled President’s Emergency Plan for Aid;**
6 **April 1, 2010 through March 31, 2011.**

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8 WHEREAS, UCSF is the recipient of a grant award from the Centers for Disease
9 Control (CDC) to fund a project entitled “President’s Emergency Plan for Aid;” and,

10 WHEREAS, Through this grant UCSF has agreed to fund DPH in the amount of
11 \$200,331 for the period of April 1, 2010 through March 31, 2011; and,

12 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH
13 for four existing positions, two Senior Physician Specialists (Job Class #2232) at 0.40 FTE
14 and 0.20 FTE, one Manager I (Job Class #0922) at 0.10 FTE, and one Epidemiologist II (Job
15 Class #2803) at 0.20 FTE, for the period of April 1, 2010 through March 31, 2011; and,

16 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, UCSF requires the City to
17 enter into an agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
18 Board of Supervisors in File No. _____; which is hereby declared to be a part of
19 this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

20 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because the DPH did
21 not receive the Agreement until May 24, 2010 and,

22 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of
23 \$21,464; now, therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant in the
25 amount of \$200,331 from UCSF; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
 2 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,
 3 be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions
 5 funded under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when
 6 the agreement expires; and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
 8 agreement on behalf of the City.
