This portion of the agenda allows any Board member to request that the Legislative Analyst provide assistance to the Board as a whole including, but not limited to: analyzing introduced legislation, analyzing policy issues and providing assistance to Board of Supervisors' task forces and advisory committees. Such requests shall be listed under this agenda heading in the order received by the Clerk of the Board including the title of relevant legislation, if applicable. Any request of the Board as a whole to the Legislative Analyst requires six affirmative votes; and be it

FURTHER MOVED, That Rule 3.12 concerning the Imperative Calendar be renumbered to Rule 3.13, 3.13.1 and 3.13.2.
