14 WHEREAS, On July 30, 2013, Supervisor Mar introduced legislation amending the
15 San Francisco Planning Code to expand the definition of formula retail to include businesses
16 that have eleven or more outlets worldwide, and to include businesses 50% or more owned by
17 formula retail businesses; to expand the applicability of formula retail controls to other types of
18 retail uses; to expand the notification procedures for formula retail applications; to require an
19 economic impact report as part of the formula retail conditional use application; and making
20 environmental findings and findings of consistency with the General Plan and the eight priority
21 policies of Planning Code Section 101.1.; and

22 WHEREAS, On August 8, 2013, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors referred the
23 proposed ordinance to the Planning Commission, which currently is reviewing the proposed
24 ordinance; and

1 WHEREAS, The Board, in accordance with Planning Code Section 306.4(d) may, by
2 Resolution, extend the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission is to render its
3 decision on proposed amendments to the Planning Code that the Board of Supervisors
4 initiates; and

5 WHEREAS, Supervisor Mar has requested additional time to allow the Planning
6 Commission and the public to review the proposed Ordinance; and

7 WHEREAS, The Board deems it appropriate in this instance to grant to the Planning
8 Commission additional time to review the proposed Ordinance and render its decision; now,
9 therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED, That by this Resolution, the Board hereby extends the prescribed time
11 within which the Planning Commission may render its decision on the proposed Ordinance for
12 an additional 60 days, until January 7, 2014.
