16	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds the PHFE requires DPH to enter into
17	a Grant Agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
18	Supervisors in File No. 090911 , which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if
19	set forth fully within; and,
20	WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and reimburses DPH for
21	one existing position: Chief Medical Director (Job Class 2237) at 0.30 FTE for the period from
22	April 10, 2009 through March 31, 2010; and,
23	WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of
24	\$15,638; now, therefore, be it
