

1 [Contract funds to develop an electronic reporting system for results of hepatitis testing.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH), to**
4 **renew a contract agreement with Public Health Foundation Enterprises, Inc. (PHFE) the**
5 **primary contractor, and expend funds in the amount of \$141,413 to develop a secure**
6 **electronic reporting system of hepatitis testing results; for the period of December 30,**
7 **2005 to December 29, 2006.**

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9 WHEREAS, SFDPH and PHFE have agreed to renew a contract agreement to
10 participate in this project; and,

11 WHEREAS, PHFE has agreed to reimburse SFDPH in the amount of \$141,413 from
12 this award under the terms of this contract agreement; and,

13 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving these funds, PHFE requires SFDPH to enter
14 into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
15 Supervisors in File No. _____; which is hereby declared to be a part of this
16 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

17 WHEREAS, The terms of the contract agreement prohibit including indirect costs in the
18 grant budget; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter into a contract agreement in
20 the amount of \$141,413 with PHFE, the primary contractor; and, be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
22 indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
24 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

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1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions
2 funded under this agreement as “G” or grant-funded positions which would terminate when
3 the agreement expires.
