1	[Lease of space for cellular transmission at Alemany Farmers' Market Property]
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3	Resolution authorizing the lease of space for up to three cellular transmission sites at
4	the property commonly known as the Alemany Farmers' Market located at the corner of
5	Alemany Boulevard and Putnam Street
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7	WHEREAS, The Alemany Farmers' Market is located on certain real property at the
8	corner of Alemany Boulevard and Putnam Street, Block 5731, Lot 002, (the "Property") owned
9	by the City under the jurisdiction of the Real Estate Division ("RED") of the City and County of
10	San Francisco (the "City"); and,
11	WHEREAS, The Property is ideally located for placement of cellular transmission sites,
12	given the proximity of freeways and major roadways; and,
13	WHEREAS, Rental income generated from such cellular transmission sites on the
14	Property would provide needed funds for improvements to the Property; now, therefore be it
15	RESOLVED, That the Director of Property is hereby authorized to solicit interest from
16	telecommunication companies for potential leases on up to three cellular transmission sites on
17	the Property, such leases in the form of the City's standard telecommunication leases and for
18	initial terms of up to five years, with the tenants having the right to extend such leases for up
19	to five additional years; and, be it
20	FURTHER RESOLVED, That following the receipt of all necessary Planning
21	Commission approvals, the Director of Property shall be authorized, but not required, to enter
22	into three leases consistent with the terms set forth in this Resolution; and, be it
23	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby finds that it is in the
24	best interests of the City to enter into such leases based upon direct negotiations without a
25	competitive bid process because competitive bidding in this situation would be impracticable

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1	or impossible, assufficient space exists for additional telecommunication companies to place
2	transmitters or antennas on the Property; and, be it
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the beginning rent charged under the leases shall be fair
4	market rent consistent with rent charged for the same use of comparable City-owned
5	locations, with annual rent increases based upon the Consumer Price Index.
