6 WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 18 would place a \$2.1 billion bond
7 for safe neighborhood parks, clean water, and coastal protection
8 on the 2000 ballot; and

9 WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 18, sponsored by Assembly Speaker
10 Villaraigosa and Assembly Speaker pro Tempore Fred Keeley,
11 addresses two decades of neglect and underfunding at
12 California's state and neighborhood parks and recreation
13 facilities; and

14 WHEREAS, California's system of state and neighborhood
15 parks, open space, and coastal habitats has been deteriorating
16 over the past two decades while demand for parks, beaches, and
17 recreational facilities has far exceeded available resources;
18 and

19 WHEREAS, The California Legislature approved the historic
20 statewide bond measure and the legislation must be signed by
21 Governor Davis; and be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County
23 of San Francisco endorses Assembly Bill 18 and urges the Governor to
24 approve the bill to place this important bond issues on the ballot;




