FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to his Honor, the Mayor, with a request that he transmit copies to the delegation from San Francisco in the State Legislature, as well as to Governor Davis, with a request that they take all action necessary to approve Assembly Bill 18.
